



Dear Bishops,

The Young Women's camp committee would like to invite you or your representative to join us for dinner at camp Thursday, June 22nd at 6pm. We would love to have you join us for all or any part of the evening's activities. Please prepare a message pertaining to the theme of camp from you, prepared especially for them.

Our theme at camp this year is, "Unwavering", which follows the youth theme of 2017 that comes from James 1:5-6. Our goal this year is to strengthen the girls' testimonies of faith in God as we pray unto Him, and that through faith, the power of prayer can change a person's life.

We need the assistance of the priesthood throughout the stake from every ward and branch. Four priesthood holders present every day and night are needed, whether they are the same or not. There will be a sign-up list available on the camp website to look at and choose a shift. Please email or call Lydia Fussell to provide names and contact information. If someone is sharing a shift with another by switching during that shift, then please indicate so by placing both names on one name line. Upon arrival at camp, please check-in with Brother James Sauls, who will be helping Tirzah Millerd in the kitchen.

It is recommended to coordinate with other units close by for gathering enough priesthood needed and to pair up if desired. We hope for at least one priesthood leader from every unit to be involved. There are enough units in our stake that it's feasible for two men from each unit to be available for a shift.

Camp this year will consist of cabins with twin bed sleeping arrangements. Priesthood will have their own sleeping quarters. Please bring a twin fitted sheet, blanket, and pillow as well as all other items needed during your stay. There is a checklist for all campers to refer to on the camp website. RVs are allowed at the campsite, but would have to be self-maintained as there aren't RV hook-ups available. Breakfast, lunch, and dinner are served to everyone, including priesthood, while at camp.

So far, we do not have specific assignments for priesthood holders at camp other than the fact that we want two men out late making sure campers aren't out of their cabins. We will be keeping a strict curfew this year. Please come prepared to jump in for anything, especially with assisting in fire and cooking certifications. Instructions for these certifications will be given to the girls, if the men would assist with the hands on part of the activity.
