Definition of COMPACT

: an agreement or covenant between two or more parties

Origin of COMPACT

Latin *compactum*, from neuter of *compactus*, past participle of *compacisci* to make an agreement, from *com-* + *paciscito* contract — more at [PACT](#)

First Known Use: 1591
